- Unemployed / Underemployed.
- Having a degree or equivalent.
- Looking for jobs that can be done via online.

Space Requirements

- Seating for 60 people.
- Working space Tables, Chairs.
- Conference / meeting room.
- Internet & Plug points.
- Power backup for wifi routers.

- 5. Inspire the youth to gain skills & get good paying jobs.


Model
